Talking about money

Year 5 and 6 students

This two-part module examines how people think, feel and act with money, including how to have constructive conversations about money with family and friends.

Students learn how to save, manage, and spend money, explore needs versus wants and the digitisation of money.



Spending and saving money

Year 7 and 8 students

This two-part module explores spending and saving choices, how decisions now can affect future finances and how conscious consumers can positively impact people and the planet.

Students learn about influences on saving, spending and payment options, and develop strategies to achieve their goals.



Making money work

Year 9 and 10 students

This two-part module explores ways to make money, and how earning money in line with values and life goals can help build future financial independence.

Students learn practical skills including navigating the workplace, reading payslips, pay rates and managing tax and superannuation.



Becoming scam savvy

Year 7 to 10 students

This single module is created to help high school students recognise scam red flags and stay safe online.

Students explore the common elements of different types of scams. They understand how to protect themselves and respond to scams, including seeking help.
