

# Money lessons for life

Talk Money with Ecstra Foundation is designed to help Australian school students learn money lessons for life, to be confident talking about money and to make informed financial decisions. The program is provided at no cost to schools, enabling more students to access financial education at key life stages.

Talk Money workshops are delivered in person or virtually by trained facilitators, providing an engaging and interactive learning experience.

## Program structure

Talk Money offers two facilitator led workshops for Year 5-10 students and teacher resources to reinforce learning and key concepts between workshops.

Talk Money workshops and resources are evidence based and aligned to the Australian Curriculum and the National Consumer and Financial Literacy Framework.



## Modules

### Talking about money

Year 5 and 6 students

This module examines how people think, feel and act with money, including how to have constructive conversations about money with family and friends.

Students learn how to save, manage, and spend money, explore needs versus wants and the digitisation of money.

### Spending and saving money

Year 7 and 8 students

This module explores spending and saving choices, how decisions now can affect future finances and how conscious consumers can positively impact people and the planet.

Students learn about influences on saving, spending and payment options, and develop strategies to achieve their goals.

### Making money work

Year 9 and 10 students

This module explores ways to make money, and how earning money in line with values and life goals can help build future financial independence.

Students learn practical skills including navigating the workplace, reading payslips, pay rates and managing tax and superannuation.
